REGISTRATION

Registration begins April 1 for the 2017-18 school year. There is a \$30 non-refundable registration fee per family per school year due with the registration form. RAD exam and class award fees are included in tuition.

PLACEMENT

Placement - Students will be placed in a level appropriate for both their age and level of physical and/or technical development. Our instructors are trained professionals providing age appropriate dance training for all young artists. Placement within a level is subject to change solely at the discretion of the Artistic Director.

Payment & Registration

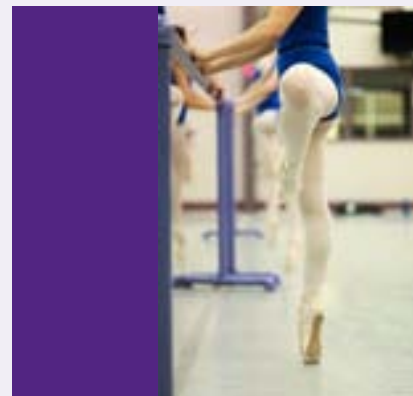
- Registration and payment must be completed prior to beginning classes.
- Classes are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Students registered at the Alabama Ballet School are registered for the entire school year and are responsible for payment through the end of the school year, unless written notification is received the month prior to withdrawal.
- Tuition is non-refundable beyond the first day of class, except in the case of serious illness or injury, verified by a doctor's written confirmation.
- Class size is limited to insure quality instruction.
- Scholarship/financial aid form deadline: September 7th to be considered for the current year.
- Classes which do not meet quota will be canceled.
